


Reset Speak:

Reset speaker system:

When the speaker is on, press and hold TWS for 5 seconds to clear all Bluetooth records including (TWS), Turn the speaker off, then turn the speaker on again to start a new Bluetooth pairing.




* You might need to Reset the Speaker if it's not in correct connection with your devices.
*After the reset, remove "BT SOUND" from your device first and then search the pair name again.



After the rest is successful, make sure the speaker is powered off and on again before starting a new connection.







1. General EQ or Bass Boost Mode Selection.
2. RGB Light Power ON/OFF.
 - Single press to switch different color style.
 - Press 2S to turn on/off the lighting effect.
3. Voice navigation function switch button.
(Microphone volume/microphone high and low frequency/microphone effect/Instrument volume)
Adjust the size key is operated on the No.5 knob, and the volume is displayed according to the RGB lamp
4. Power ON/OFF Button.
Press once to turn on the speaker
Press and hold for 5 second to turn off the speaker
5. Volume+/Volume-/Play/Pause/Previous song /Next song.
Check remaining battery capacity with speaker on:
Turn volume button once, and wait 2 second, and notice color of LED shown.
 - Green - battery level is greater than 30%
 - Yellow - battery level is between 20% and 30%.
 - Red - battery level is less than 20%.
6. Function indicator light.(shown no page 5).
7. Type-c charging port.(OTG)Digital live streaming interface.
8. Instrument input (6.35mm).
9. Microphone Input (6.35mm).
10. TWS connection button.((shown no page 9).
11. USB - A Port: you can play MP3 music through memory stick.
12. 3.5mm Four-core LINE-IN audio input/mobile phone analog live broadcast port.
13. 3.5mm Three-core LINE-IN audio output.
14. DC 12V/5A DC power input.
15. RGB Light.


True Wireless Stereo (TWS)

1. Make sure both speakers are Bluetooth on. Press one of the speaker TWS buttons to connect.
When the TWS indicator turns green and an announcement is made, the TWS connection is complete, and the TWS indicator of the secondary unit blinks.
2. you press the TWS speaker will become the host/left channel, long press to disconnect the TWS connection.
3. cancel the TWS connection: press the TWS button for 5 seconds for each of the two boxes, and press the power button respectively to shut down and restart.
4. the microphone must be connected to the host speaker.



Counterclockwise rotation (Reduce volume) Press three times (Previous Song) Press Once (Pause) Press twice (Next Song) Clockwise rotation (increase volume)

CHARGE POWER TWS/BT


TWS/BT: When connected in TWS mode, the secondary unit flashes, Bluetooth mode is always on and flashes when Bluetooth pairing is successful.

POWER: Always on when the power is turned on, flashing when voltage is low, and the power amplifier function is turned off.


CHARGE: Charging is always on, flashing when battery fail or temperature is too high

OTG Digital recording



Internal recording: The phone only records the sound through the speaker device, and external noise and noise cannot be recorded to ensure the purity of the sound.

Android/Live recording on mobile phone:

Android /Harmony OS, and tablets require downloading third-party APP software to record videos using the recording function provided by the software.

IOS mobile recording live streaming:

After connecting to the OTG internal recording cable on Apple phones and tablets, turn on the built-in recording function to record videos (third-party software can also be used).

Live recording: After connecting the OTG recording cable, open the app's live streaming function to transmit the speaker signal to the phone.

*To reduce background noise during live recording, do not use AC power to power speakers, mobile phones, and other devices. Battery powered devices have lower background noise, and OTG live recording cables should not fall to the ground. When not in use, unplug the audio cable to avoid idle interference.
